Parkinson’s disease (PD) is a chronic, degenerative neurological disorder characterized by symptoms that typically progress from mild tremors to complete physical incapacitation. PD is generally thought of as a disease of the “old” generation with the average onset at age 60. However, young onset at ages of 30 or younger is estimated to be 5-10% of

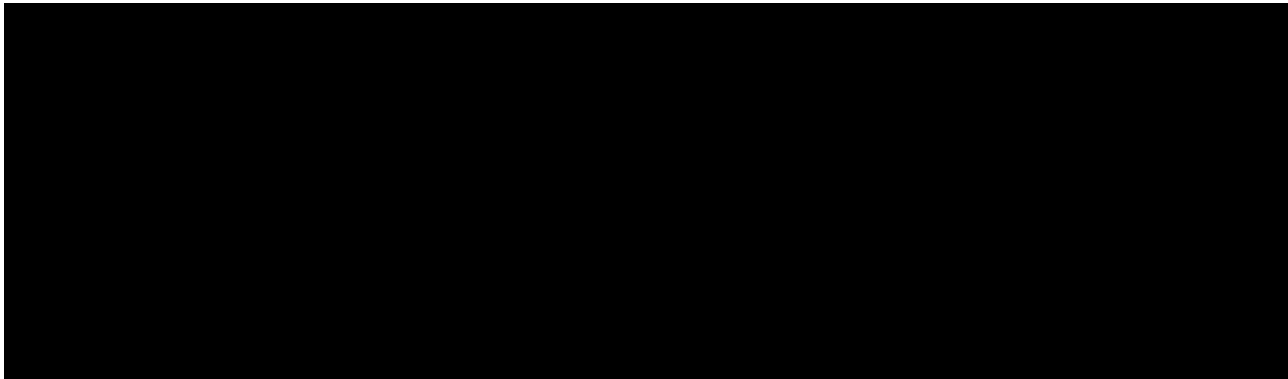
the 5 MILLION people worldwide with PD. One new case is diagnosed every nine minutes. There is no known cure for Parkinson's disease. Currently, available treatments temporarily mask symptoms while the disease continues to get worse.

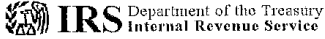
